



Off-Setting an Edge to Edge

- Press **Design**.
- Press File.
- Press Open.
- Double tap on:



- Designs/HQ Designs/ Continuous Line/Clam Shell with Curl
- Press Area.
- Move machine to the top left corner of quilt top.
- Press 2 Corner.
- Move machine to the right edge of the quilt.
- Press 2 Corner.


Type in the height of the quilt since the machine cannot reach the bottom of the quilt.




- Press Repeat.
- Press Main.



• Press Fit.



- Using the "plus" button add more Horizontal and Vertical repeats if you like more.
- Tip: The more repeats you add the smaller each design will become.




- Press Stretch Width.
- Stretch Height.
- Press Wrapping.



• Press the "1/2" Button that is associated with




If a design needs more or less than a 50% offset, then press the directional arrows that are associated with the Row Function. You can also type in a number in the number box to create a desired offset.



 Press Closed. Each loose end created after cropping the side will be tied to the next end point by stitching along the border of the area to get to the next point.

• Press Baseline. Important!



- Press Quilt.
- Press **Run.** Verify settings.
- Press Proceed.
