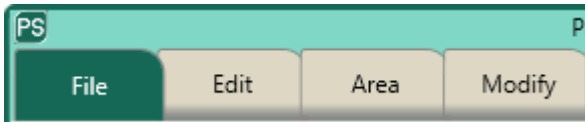


## Create and Save a Circle Area

Create a circle area, save and use anytime you need a circle area to resize, position or align.

### 1. Select Design

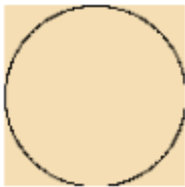
- Select **File** tab. The circle design in the workspace will be used as a background design to create a circle area.



- Press **Design**.

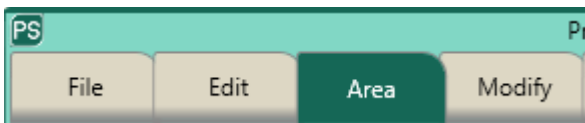


- Press **Open**.
- Select **Designs/HQ Designs/Block/Circle**



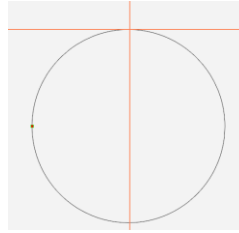
### 2. Create an Area

- Select **Area** tab.

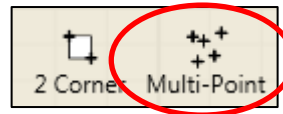


- The circle design in the workspace will be used as a guide to create a circle area.

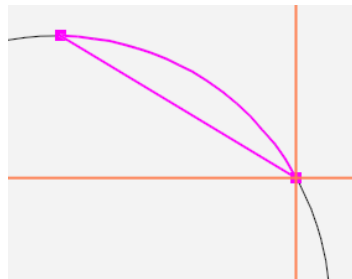
- Move crosshair to the circle line.



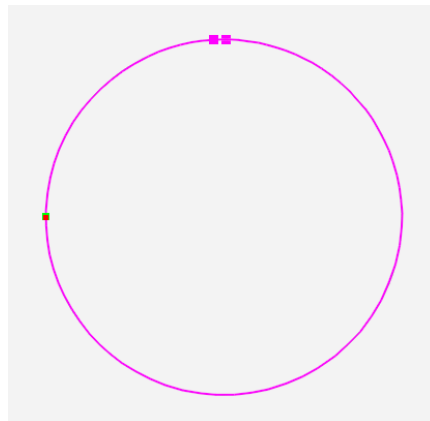
- Press **Multi-Point**.



- Move machine  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch to the right.
- Press **Multi-Point**.
- Continue moving around the circle pressing **Multi-Point** every  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch. The closer the multi-points are together the more accurate the circle.
- This small amount of the area created has 18 points.

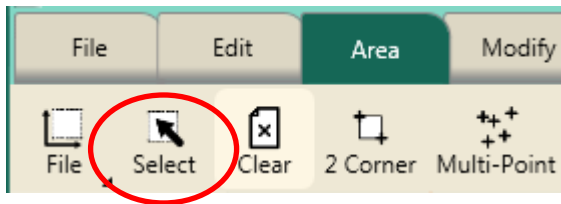


This 6" x 6" circle has 78 points. The advantage of creating an area that has many points is the accuracy of the area.

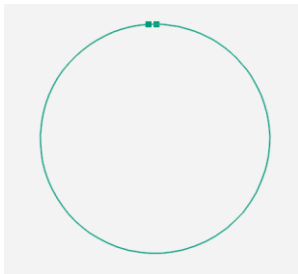


### 3. Save Circle Area

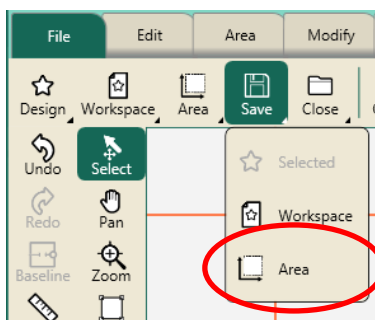
- Press **Select** under the Area tab.



- The circle area will turn green.



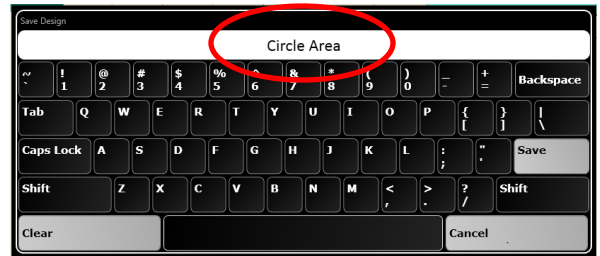
- Select **File** tab.
- Press **Save**.



- A drop-down box will appear.
- Press **Area**.
- A window will open allowing you to save the circle area for future use.
- Touch the area bar.



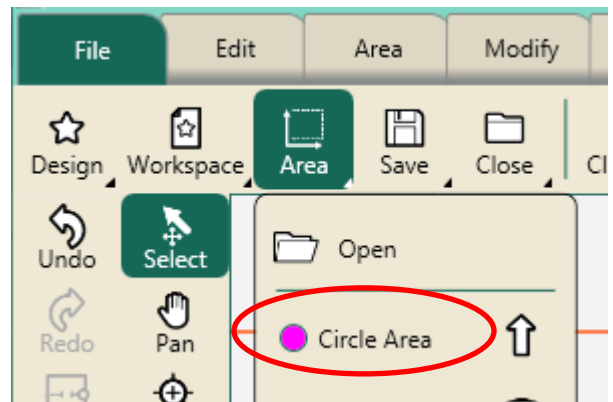
- A keyboard will appear allowing you to type in the name of the area.



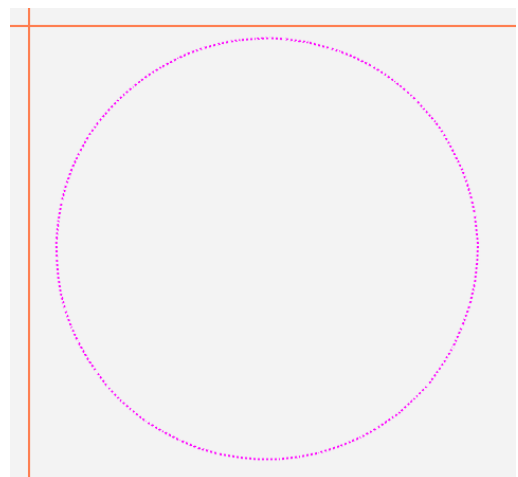
- Press **Save** on the keyboard.
- Press **Clear All**. This closes the circle design and the area in the workspace.

### 4. Open Circle Area

- Select **File** tab.
- Press **Area**.
- Press **Circle Area**.

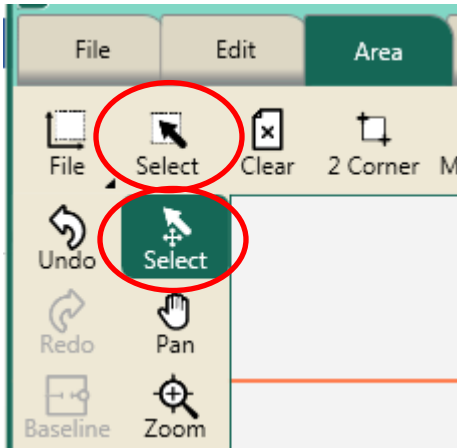


- The Circle Area will appear in the workspace as a pink dashed circle.

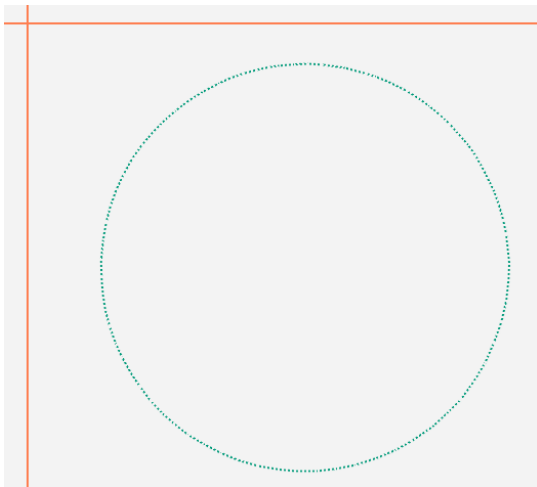


## 4. Reposition the Area

- Select **Area** tab.
- Press **Select** in the **Area** ribbon or **Select** in the workspace tools.



- The circle area will turn green ready to edit.

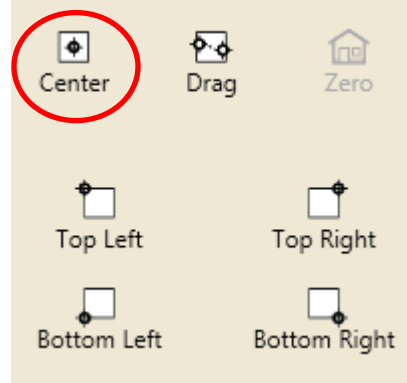


- Select **Modify** tab.
- Press **Reposition**.

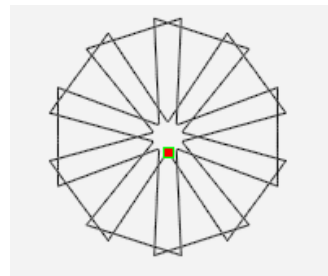


- Move the crosshairs to the center of the block on quilt.

- Press **Center** in the sidebar.



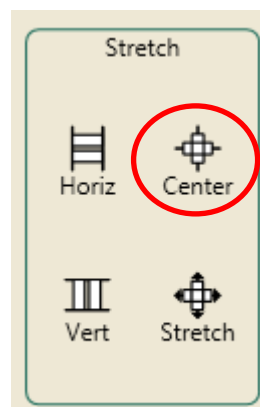
- This will center the circle area in the block.
- Select desired design from file.
- In this example **Around You Go** in **HQ Designs/Blocks** was chosen.



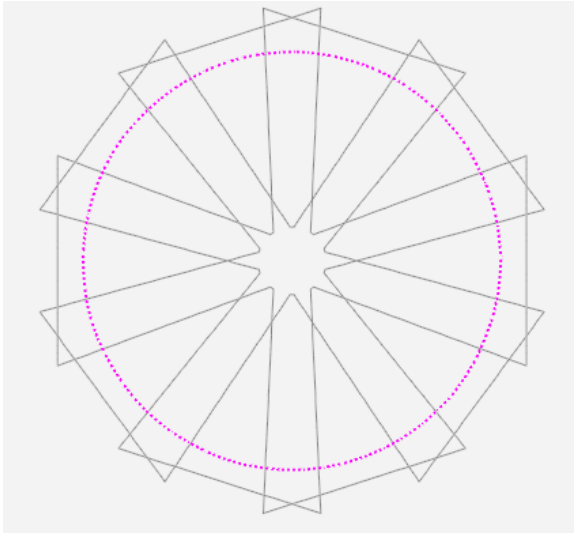
- Select **Modify** tab.
- Press **Align**.



Press **Center**.



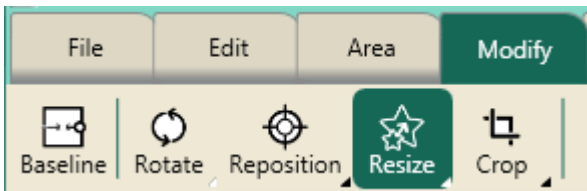
- The design will center over the circle area.



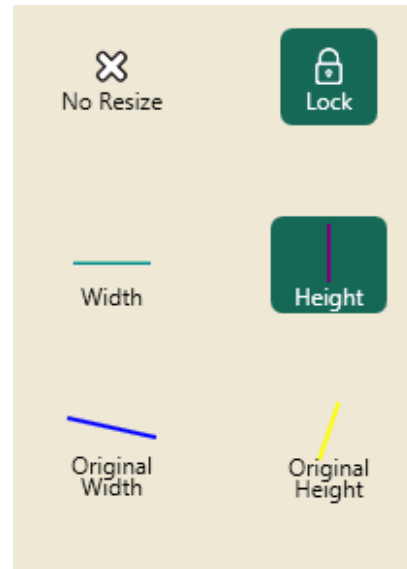
- The design is too large for the circle area.

## 5. Resize the design.

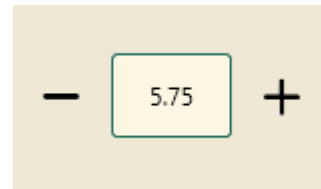
- Select **Modify** tab.
- Press **Resize**.



- Press **Lock**.



- Press the **Minus (-)** button to decrease the design to the desired size.



- The design now fits in the area.
