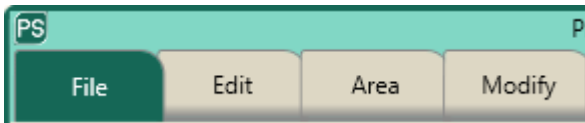


Using 2 Point Rotation

Rotate a design using 2 Point Rotation to place in a sashing on an angle.

1. Select Design

- Select **File** tab.



- Press **Design**.

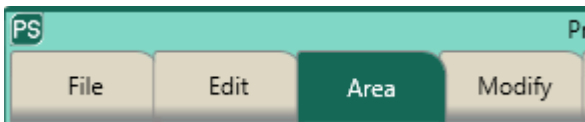


- Press **Open**.
- Select **Designs/HQ Designs/Continuous Line/Leaves with Spines**

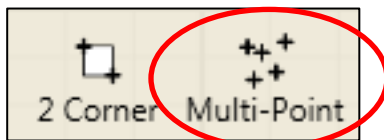


2. Create an Area

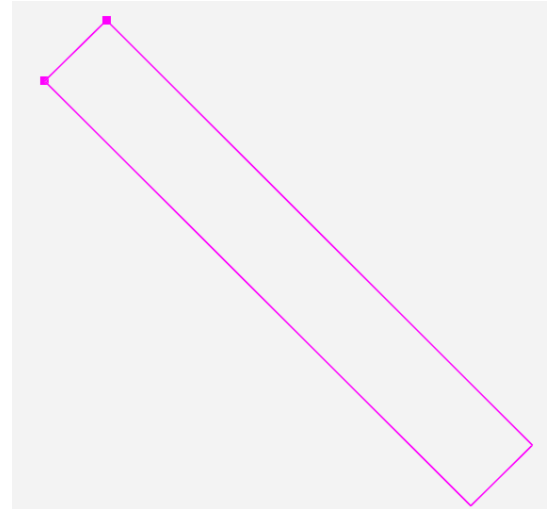
- Select **Area** tab.



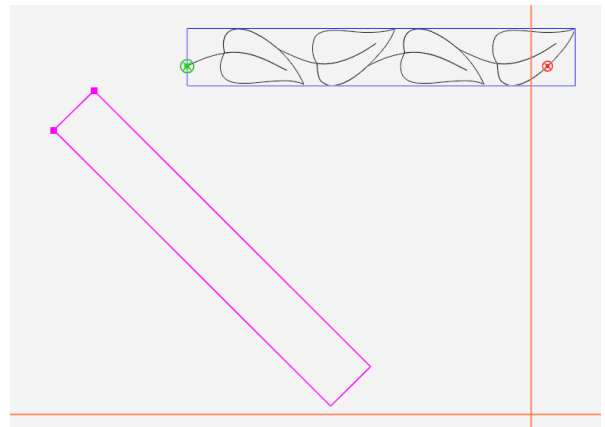
- Move machine to a corner of the sashing on the quilt.
- Press **Multi-Point**.



- Continue moving the machine and pressing **Multi-Point** at the other three corners of the sashing block. There should be four points for the area.



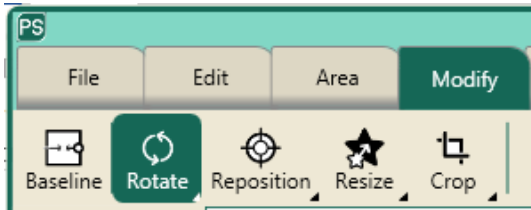
- The area now appears as a pink rectangle.
- Press **Refresh** in the status bar at the bottom of the screen. The area, design and crosshairs will be visible in the workspace.



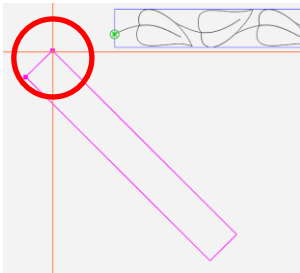
Note: The Leaves with Spines design has been repeated two times to fit in the 1.4 x 9.9 area.

3. Rotate Design

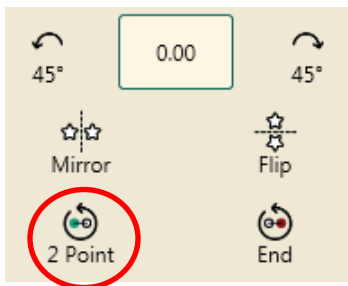
- Select **Modify** tab.



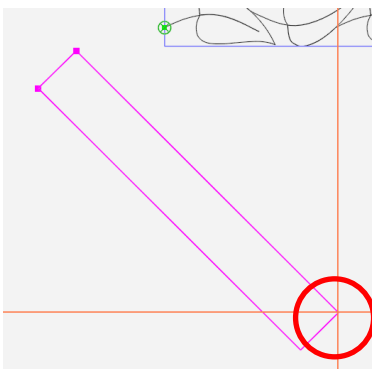
- Press **Rotate**.
- Move the crosshairs to the top left corner of the sashing.



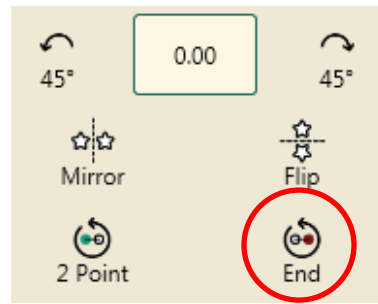
- Press **2 Point** in the sidebar on the right side of the screen.



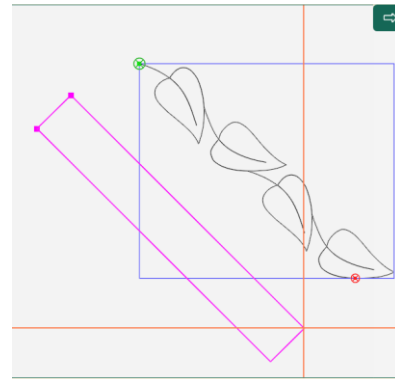
- Move crosshairs to the top right corner.



- Press **End** in the sidebar.



- The design will automatically rotate to the angle of the area.



- Notice the angle in the box on the sidebar.
